ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, from time to time, emergency vehicles and equipment used by the City of Chicago become outdated and obsolete and are replaced; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago's Department of General Services from time to time has in its possession fire trucks that, while no longer of use to the City, could be of use to another worthy entity; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Museum of Greater Chicago is part of the Chicago Fire Department Charities, Inc. a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, that preserves the history, heritage, and artifacts of the fire service by providing education, research, and displays; and


WHEREAS, the Fire Museum of Greater Chicago is in need of artifacts from the Chicago Fire Department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Commissioner of the Department of General Services is hereby authorized to donate obsolete Fire Department Truck 671 Deluge Unit, which is no longer useful to the City of Chicago, to the Fire Museum of Greater Chicago, or its designee, free and clear of any liens or encumbrances. The City shall convey said truck in "as is" condition without any warranties either expressed or implied and expressly excludes any warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

SECTION 2. The Commissioner of the Department of General Services is hereby authorized to enter into and execute such other documents, as may be necessary and proper to implement this donation.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
