## **ORDINANCE**

### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (42.10), as follows:

#### **4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.**


Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

(42.10) Within the area described as follows: beginning at the intersection of West Grand Avenue and North Orleans Street thence southerly on North Orleans Street to the north bank of the Chicago River; thence westerly on the north bank of the Chicago River to the east bank of the Chicago River; thence northerly on the east bank of the Chicago River to West Grand Avenue; thence easterly on West Grand Avenue to the intersection of North Orleans Street and West Grand Avenue.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
