WHEREAS, Justice McMorrow retired from the bench in 2006 a revered and highly decorated figure, whose myriad well-deserved honors included the Medal of Excellence Award from the Loyola University School of Law Alumni Association, the Fellows of the Illinois Bar Foundation Award for Distinguished Service to Law and Society, Chicago Lawyer Magazine's Person of the Year, the American Bar Association's Margaret Brent Award, and, perhaps most fittingly, the Women's Bar Association of Illinois's Myra Bradwell Woman of Achievement Award, which is named after the first woman admitted to the Illinois Bar; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Justice McMorrow was called to eternal life by the wisdom of God on February 23, 2013; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. East Congress Plaza Drive is hereby renamed as "Chief Justice Mary Ann Grohwin McMorrow Plaza Drive."

SECTION 2. The Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to do all such acts and things he deems necessary, advisable or appropriate to effectuate this ordinance, including without limitation, the placement of street name signs with the new street name, and to furnish and install a commemorative marker near the intersection of Chief Justice Mary Ann Grohwin McMorrow Plaza Drive and East Congress Parkway honoring Chief Justice Mary Ann Grohwin McMorrow.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
