SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE - A7714

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO-

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B3-1 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 24-E in the area bounded by

The public alley next north of and parallel to East 103 Street; a perpendicular line to East 103rd Street 100 feet east of and parallel to South Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive; East 103rd Street; a perpendicular line to East 103rd Street 75 feet east of and parallel to South Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive,

to those of an RSI Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.
