

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mayor and the Chicago City Council urges US Senator Durbin and US Senator Kirk to support postal reform legislation that would: Secure the continuance of 6-day mail delivery; Stabilize the Postal Service's finances by reforming or eliminating future retiree health financing policies that are crippling the Postal Service's finances; Strengthen and protect the Postal Service's invaluable mail processing, retail and last-mile delivery networks that together comprise a crucial part of the nation's infrastructure; Retain door-to-door delivery for 30 million plus households and businesses; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Chicago City Council transmit copies of this resolution to the President and Vice President of the United States, to the Majority Leader of the Senate, to both US Senator Durbin and US Senator Kirk, and to the United States Postmaster General.
