### Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to GRASS FED, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, three (3) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1721 N. Damen Ave..

### Said Awning(s) at N. Damen measure(s):

One (1) at three point three three (3.33) feet in length, and two point one six (2.16) feet in width for a total of seven point one nine (7.19) square feet.

One (1) at seven point five (7.5) feet in length, and two point one six (2.16) feet in width for a total of sixteen point two (16.2) square feet.

One (1) at seven point five (7.5) feet in length, and two point one six (2.16) feet in width for a total of sixteen point two (16.2) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1103160 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs
