ORDINANCE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 9-64-206 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored, as follows:

9-64-206 Parking meters - Hours of operation.

 - 7 3706 to 3812 North Clark Street.
 - 13.8 3002 to 3439 North Sheffield Avenue.
 - 13.9 3204 to 3953 North Southport Avenue.
 - 13.10 3603 to 3611 North Ashland Avenue, east side of the street.
 - 13.11 3905 to 3951 North Ashland Avenue.
 - 12 422 to 674 West Diversey Parkway, north side of the street.

- 13 600 to 1156 West Belmont Avenue.
- 14 1200 block of West Belmont Avenue, north side of the street.
- 15 1400 block of West Belmont Avenue, north side of the * street.

13.16 932 to 957 West Addison Street.
