# ORDINANCE

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding a new Section 8-4-350, as follows:

#### Reserved 8-4-350 Enhanced penalties for offenses committed in public transportation safety zones

(a) <u>Definition. For purposes of this section, "public transportation safety zone" means:</u>

1) <u>any bus, train, or other form of transportation operated by a transportation authority</u> that is funded, in whole or in part, with public funds;

2) <u>in, or within 100 feet of, any building, real property, or parking area under the control of a public transportation authority that is funded, in whole or in part, with public funds; and</u>

3) within 100 feet of any bus shelter or sign designating the location of a bus stop utilized by a transportation authority that is funded, in whole or in part, with public funds.

(b) <u>Penalties.</u>

1) <u>The following enhanced penalties shall apply to violations of sections 8-20-075 and 8-20</u> -085 of this Code that occur in public transportation safety zones:

A) <u>the penalty for a first offense shall be a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$5.000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 120 days nor more than six months;</u>

B) the penalty for a second offense shall be a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 nor more than \$15,000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 150 days nor more than six months; and

C) <u>the penalty for a third or subsequent offense shall be a fine of not less than</u> \$10,000.00 nor more than \$20,000.00, and incarceration for a term of six months. 2) <u>The following enhanced penalties shall apply to violations of section 8-20-060 of this</u> <u>Code that occur in public transportation safety zones:</u>

A) <u>the penalty for a first offense shall be a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$5,000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 30 days nor more than six months;</u>

B) the penalty for a second offense shall be a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 nor more than \$15,000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 90 days nor more than six months; and

C) <u>the penalty for a third or subsequent offense shall be a fine of not less than</u> \$10,000.00 nor more than \$20,000.00, and incarceration for a term of six months.

3) <u>The following enhanced penalties shall apply to violations of section 8-24-020 of this</u> <u>Code that occur in public transportation safety zones:</u>

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A) <u>the penalty for a first offense shall be a fine of not less than \$500.00 nor more</u> than \$1,000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 30 days nor more than six months;

B) the penalty for a second offense shall be a fine of not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$2,000.00, and incarceration for a term not less than 90 days nor more than six months; and

(C) the penalty for a third or subsequent offense shall be a fine of not less than \$2,000.00 nor more than \$5,000.00, and incarceration for a term of six months.

SECTION 2. Section 8-20-300 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

# 8-20-300 Violation - Penalty.

(a) Unless the enhanced penalty imposed by subsection 8-4-350(b)(2) or subsection 8-4-355(b)(2) of this Code applies, any person who violates section  $8 \cdot 20 \cdot 020$ ,  $8 \cdot 20 \cdot 030$ ,  $8-20 \cdot 060$ , or  $8 \cdot 20 \cdot 080$  shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$5,000.00, and be incarcerated for a term not less than 20 days nor more than 90 days.

Unless the enhanced penalty imposed by subsection 8-4-350(b)(1) or subsection 8-4-355(b)(1) of this Code applies, any person who violates section 8-20.035,  $8-20-075_7$  or 8-20-085, 8-20-110, or 8-20-280 shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$1,000.00 nor more than \$5,000.00, and be incarcerated for a term not less than 90 days nor more than 180 days.

SECTION 3. Section 8-24-020 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

#### 8-24-020 Carrying dangerous weapons.

#### (Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

(g) Unless the enhanced penalty imposed by subsection 8-4-350(b)(3) or subsection 8-4-355(b)(3) of this Code applies, a person violating the provisions of subsections (a), (c), (d), or (f) of this section shall be fined \$200.00 for each offense, or shall be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

#### (Omitted text is not affected by this ordinance)

SECTION 4. In light of the urgent need to activate the deterrent effect of these enhanced penalties, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/1-2-4, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, if such passage is by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of this Council. In the event this ordinance passes by a majority vote of less than two-thirds of the members of this Council, it shall take effect ten days after passage and publication.

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
