ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 17-3-0207 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting in the table the language underscored, as follows:

SECTION 2. Section 17-17-0104 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored as followed:

17-17-0104- Medical Service. Personal health services including prevention, diagnosis and treatment, methadone clinics, rehabilitation services provided by physicians, dentists, nurses, and other health personnel and medical testing and analysis services. Typical uses include medical and dental offices, medical/dental laboratories, health maintenance organizations and government-operated health centers. Excludes use types more specifically classified, such as hospitals.

SECTION 3. Section 17-9 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting a new Section 17-9-0129, as follows:

17-9-0129 Methadone Clinic. A methadone clinic may not be located within 1,000 feet of the property line of a pre-existing public or private preschool or elementary or secondary school, or day care center, day care home, group day care home or part day child care facility. Alderman Pat Dowell, 3rd Ward

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
