ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 8-16-020 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored and by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

8-16-020 Curfew hours for minors.

(a) Definitions. Whenever used in this section: (1) "Curfew hours" means:

- A) For minors 12 through ~~4~~ 17 years of age, 10:00 p.m. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday until 6:00 a.m. of the following day; and
- B) For minors younger than 12 years of age, 8:30 P.M. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday until 6:00 A.M. of the following day; and
- C) For minors 12 through ~~4~~ 17 years of age, 11:00 p.m. on any Friday or Saturday and until 6:00 a.m. of the following day; and

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

(5) "Minor" means any person under ~~4~~ 18 years of age.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
