LAKESIDE FOOD WINE SPIRITS

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LAKESIDE FOOD WINE SPIRITS upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use three (3) Sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 2601 N HALSTED ST.

Said Sign structure(s) measures as follows along N. Halsted Street:

One (1) at eighteen point zero eight (18.08) feet in length, one point six seven (1.67) feet in height and twelve (12) feet above grade level.

Said Sign structure(s) measures as follows along W. Wrightwood Avenue:

One (1) at eighteen point zero eight (18.08) feet in length, one point six seven (1.67) feet in height and twelve (12) feet above grade level.

Said Sign structure(s) measures as follows along N. Halsted Street:

One (1) at seven point one three (7.13) feet in length, five (5) feet in height and eleven (11) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1596473 herein granted the sum of nine hundred (\$900.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

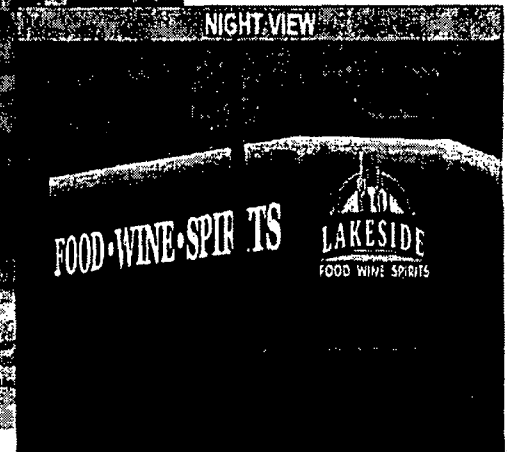
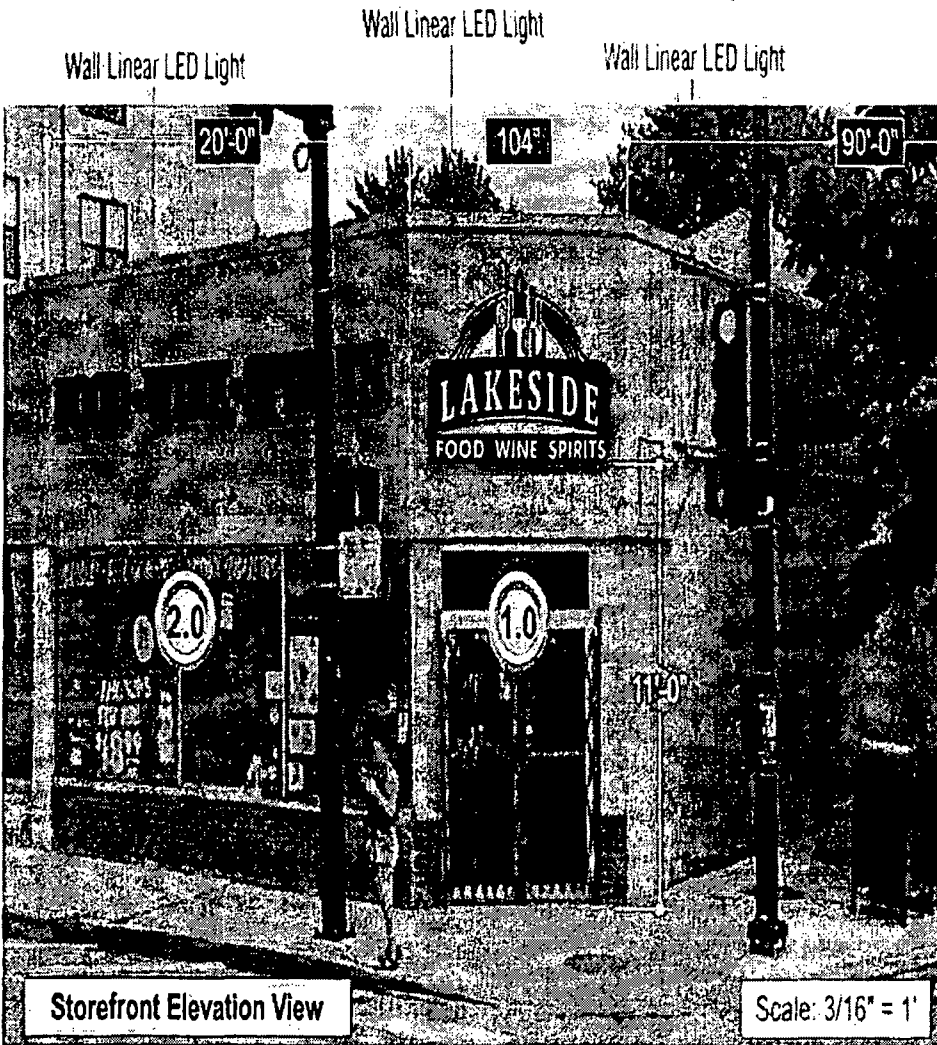
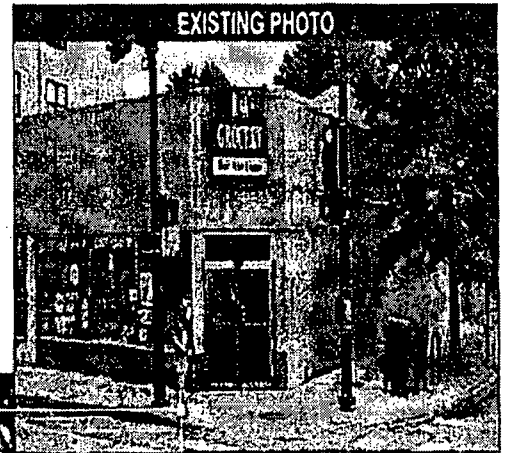
