**WHEREAS**, The Honorable Barbara Vucanovich was known for her willingness to put partisan considerations aside in favor of the best interests of Nevada; and


**WHEREAS**, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Barbara Vucanovich serve as an example to all; and
