WHEREAS, The Honorable George McGovern was elected to the United States House of Representatives in 1956 and served two terms before being elected to the United States Senate in 1962; and


WHEREAS, The Honorable George McGovern served in the United States Senate for three terms, and was the Democratic Party's nominee for President in 1972; and
