WHEREAS, The Fire Department of the City of Chicago has an outdated ambulance which could be put to great use serving the citizens of San Francisco de Macoris, Domingo Republic; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Fleet Management and the Purchasing Agent are hereby authorized to donate one outdated Fire Department ambulance which can no longer be used in the City of Chicago, to San Francisco de Macoris, Domingo Republic, free and clear of any liens and encumbrances. The City of Chicago conveys said vehicle in "as is" condition without any warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

SECTION 2. The Commissioner of Fleet Management and the Purchasing Agent are hereby authorized to enter into and execute such other documents as may be necessary and proper to implement the donation.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force hereinafter its passage and publication.
