- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rose Alkire enjoyed being a housewife and caring for their son Tom; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rose Alkire became a widow when her husband Donald passed away, after only ten years of marriage; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rose Alkire was excited and very happy when her son Tom, friends and family had a birthday party for her on July 17th, 2012, saying "I can't believe I made it this long"; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rose Alkire has lived at the Senate Apartments since 1981 and has established many friendships over the years; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rose Alkire had yet another one hundredth birthday celebration, which was well attended by residents of the Senate Apartments; and
