**ORDINANCE**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (17.254), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of March 29, 2017 at page 44794, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (17.254) On South Ashland Avenue, from West 75<sup>th</sup> Street to West 77<sup>th</sup> Street.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
