**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Monsignor Francis N. Maniola's ministry also included other assignments at St. Agatha Parish, Christ the King, Presentation BVM and Queen of Angels parishes; and


**WHEREAS,** The holiness, sacrifice and dedication of the Reverend Monsignor Francis N. Maniola serve as an example to all; and
