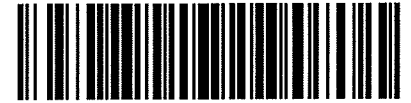

**SUBSTITUTE**  
**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as new subsections 4-60-022(16.79) through 4-60-022(16.87), as follows:

**4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(16.79) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Ashland Avenue to Laflin Street.

(16.80) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Laflin Street to Loomis Boulevard.

(16.81) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Loomis Boulevard to Throop Street.

(16.82) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Throop Street to Racine Avenue.

(16.83) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Racine Avenue to Aberdeen Street.

(16.84) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Aberdeen Street to Morgan Street.

(16.85) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Morgan Street to Peoria Street.

(16.86) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Peoria Street to Halsted Street.

(16.87) On Damen Avenue, from 51<sup>st</sup> Street to 53<sup>rd</sup> Street.

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

**SECTION 3.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as new subsections 4-60-023(16.70) through 4-60-023(16.78), as follows:

**4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(16.70) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Ashland Avenue to Laflin Street.

(16.71) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Laflin Street to Loomis Boulevard.

(16.72) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Loomis Boulevard to Throop Street.

(16.73) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Throop Street to Racine Avenue.

(16.74) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Racine Avenue to Aberdeen Street.

(16.75) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Aberdeen Street to Morgan Street.

(16.76) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Morgan Street to Peoria Street.

(16.77) On 57<sup>th</sup> Street, from Peoria Street to Halsted Street.

(16.78) On Damen Avenue, from 51<sup>st</sup> Street to 53<sup>rd</sup> Street.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.


