ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the designation and appropriate symbols and indications of a segment of the West Division Street right-of-way on Map No. 3-H in the area bounded by

The west line of North Ashland Avenue to a line 149.04 feet west of the west line of North Ashland Avenue on the south side of West Division Street

to remove all designations of such segment as a Pedestrian Street.

SECTION 2. Section 17-3-0503-D of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and inserting the underscored language as follows:

[The other pedestrian streets and pedestrian retail streets in these subsections are unaffected by the changes and are not included for editorial convenience,]

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
