**WHEREAS**, Nancy Schillerstrom inspired the lives of countless people through her great personal goodness, charity and concern; and


**WHEREAS**, A woman of dignity, grace and charm, Nancy Schillerstrom will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by her many relatives and friends; and
