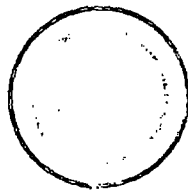

**Whereas**, Chicago Public Schools offers students opportunities to take part in a wide variety of athletic competitions to promote and develop athletic skills, teamwork, perseverance, responsibility, physical endurance, commitment, and time management, as well as promote personal and emotional health; and

**WHEREAS**, Many of our diverse, talented, and hard-working students have excelled in these competitions; and

**WHEREAS**, In the Class 2A IHSA boys soccer tournament, Eric Solorio Academy High School students Joel Estrada, Bryan Rangel Hurtado, Angel Campos, Michael B. Perez, Omar Salgado, Brian Marin, Julián Arroyo, Alejandro Sánchez, Jr., Kevin Patino, Jose Solis, Misael Rodriguez, David Diaz, Luis Batalla, Ricardo Silva-Torres, Rafael Soto, David Gamez, Roberto C. Villa, Edgar Torres, Jonathan Vasquez Cortez, and Oscar Ramirez, led by Assistant Coaches Justin Rodriguez, Miguel Ramirez, and Jesus Herrera, Head Coach Adrian Calleros, and Principal Victor Iturralde, won the state championship. Newly opened in 2010, Solorio Academy's boys soccer team captured the school's first state title in only its eighth year as a school, and fourth year as a complete grade 9-12 high school; and

**WHEREAS**, In the Class 2A IHSA girls tennis tournament, Whitney Young High School students Camryn Salter, Madison Beckham, Mackenzie Beckham, Darinka Stepan and Sarah Williams, led by Assistant Coach Carl Abram, Head Coach Dempsey Willard, and Principal Dr. Joyce Kenner, won the state championship, and is the first CPS team to win a girls' state title in tennis; and

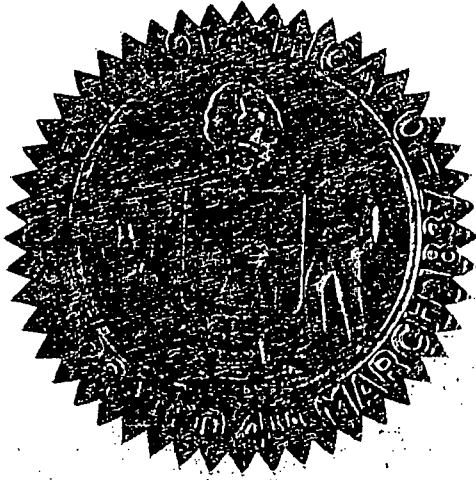

Phillips has gone to the state final four years in a row, and has won the state title in two of the last three years. This graduating senior class is the winningest in CPS football history, with a record of 51-4; and

**WHEREAS,** In the Class 1A IHSA girls tennis tournament, Northside College Preparatory High School student Nicole Roc, led by Coaches Darlene Horn and Alex Hughes, and Principal Kelly Mest, finished the season undefeated and won the singles championship. Nicole is Northside College Prep's first state champion in singles tennis, and has been awarded a full scholarship to West Virginia University, where she will compete in Division I competition in the Big 12; and

**WHEREAS,** The Members of this Chamber are pleased to congratulate all of the members of the Chicago Public Schools teams on their overwhelming success in their fields of competition; now, therefore
