WHEREAS, Deutsch, Levy & Engel has grown over the years and presently has more than thirty attorneys and an administrative staff of more than twenty; and


WHEREAS, The firm's clients include private businesses, various governmental agencies, financial institutions and many third-generation, closely-held companies; and
