***WHEREAS***, Conor Gee was officially installed as the 114<sup>th</sup> President of Rotary One, the world's first Rotary Club and service organization; and

***WHEREAS***, The Chicago City Council has been informed of this event by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

***WHEREAS***, Conor Gee was installed on June 27, 2017 during a ceremony at the Union League Club of Chicago; and

***WHEREAS***, The Rotary movement began right here in Chicago, in 1905, when a small group of businessmen formed a charitable organization dedicated to serving their community and fostering fellowship among members of the professional community

***WHEREAS***, Today, the Rotary Club of Chicago boasts over 200 members who continue to meet on a weekly basis, a dedicated Foundation (the ROTARY/One Foundation, Inc.), a vibrant calendar of guest speakers, and strong participation in service projects both in Chicago and across the world; and

***WHEREAS***, Conor Gee has now become the youngest President in the 113-year history of the Rotary Club of Chicago, where he has ably served as a member of its Board of Directors; and

***WHEREAS***, In his private life, Conor Gee is a Lead Marketing Communications Consultant for Health Care Service Corporation, the largest customer-owned health insurance company in the United State, which operates Blue Cross and Blue Shield plans in five states including Illinois;; and


