**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of 79; and

**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey was a retired New York Congressman and the loving husband of Ilene; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey was the much-adored father of three children to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey was a fierce defender of the environment and an advocate for veterans; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey was a longtime member of the House Appropriations Committee; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Maurice Hinchey retired from Congress in 2013 after 20 years on Capitol Hill and 18 years in the New York State Assembly; and

**WHEREAS,** As the Chair of the Assembly's House Environmental Conservation Committee, the Honorable Maurice Hinchey led hearings into the Love Canal catastrophe; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Maurice Hinchey serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, the Honorable Maurice Hinchey imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this thirteenth day of December, 2017, do hereby commemorate the Honorable Maurice Hinchey for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
