RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of one-hundred-one; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini was the fifteenth Governor of the State of Washington and the devoted husband of the late Ethel; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini was the much-adored father of Albert Jr., John, Jane, Sue and Lynn to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini served as Governor from 1957 to 1965 and reformed the state's prison system and modernized its mental health facilities; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini spearheaded construction of the world's longest floating bridge which crosses Lake Washington and runs between Medina and Seattle; and

WHEREAS, Prior to being elected Governor, the Honorable Albert Rosellini served for eighteen years in the Washington State Senate where he championed the creation of medical and dental schools at the University of Washington; and

WHEREAS, In his retirement, the Honorable Albert Rosellini served as a mentor and fundraiser for numerous Democratic candidates and officials in his home state; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Albert Rosellini inspired the lives of countless people through his great personal goodness, charity and concern; and


WHEREAS, The hard work, dedication and sacrifice of the Honorable Albert Rosellini serve as an example to all; and
