Ronnie established himself as a reliable and hard-working employee in 27 years as a press operator at the Chicago Tribune's Freedom Center printing plant. As a press operator, he was skilled in all four major areas of production; folding, four-color printing, press control systems, and reel room operation, he was a hard worker and dedicated to his job, carrying on a work ethic he learned from his late father, who held two jobs for much of his life; and

**WHEREAS**, Ronnie was united in Holy matrimony to Sergenet Walton on June 22, 1982, from that union two children were born a son, Brian, and a daughter Sergene; and

**WHEREAS**, Ronnie was preceded in death by his father Roy Head; he leaves behind to cherish his memory his loving wife, Sergenet; a son, Brian; a daughter, Sergene; his mother, Ceretha; two brothers, Maurice and Rayburn; a sister, Yolanda (Derry) Baggett and a host of other relatives, cousins, and friends, now, therefore,
