**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** George S. Feiwell was a widely admired member of the legal community and the loving husband of the late Marilyn; and

**WHEREAS,** George S. Feiwell was the much-adored father of Todd and Annie, the proud grandfather of four and the devoted companion of Jan Kramer; and

**WHEREAS,** As a young adult, George S. Feiwell led an adventurous life and worked as a rancher in Wyoming where he performed at rodeos and raced cars and boats; and

**WHEREAS,** George S. Feiwell earned both his undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Iowa; and

**WHEREAS,** George S. Feiwell practiced for more than six decades in local, state and federal courtrooms and tried a case which was at the time the longest jury trial in the history of the Northern District of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS,** In later years George S. Feiwell focused primarily on cases in the Domestic Relations Division of Cook County; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of George S. Feiwell serve as an example to all; and


