WHEREAS, Born in Indianapolis, Terry Glover attended high school in St. Louis before coming to Chicago to attend Northwestern University; and

WHEREAS, Terry Glover earned a master's degree in journalism from Roosevelt University and served as staff and in freelance roles for publications such as *Uptown* and *Savoy* magazines; and

WHEREAS, Terry Glover also helped to spearhead the founding of The Black Harvest Film Festival which brought to Chicago films from countries like Ghana, Great Britain, Haiti and Nigeria; and

WHEREAS, Terry Glover joined *Ebony Magazine* in 2006 and was named Managing Editor in 2009; and


WHEREAS, A woman of dignity, grace and charm, Terry Glover was an exceptional editor and a dear friend to many; and
