
**WHEREAS**, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Reverend Jerome P. Twarog serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Jerome P. Twarog will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and parishioners; and

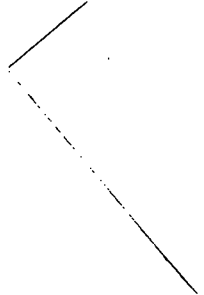
**WHEREAS**, To his beloved family, the Reverend Jerome P. Twarog imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
