SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LE PARIS BAKERY NO 2 INC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 5434 S. Pulaski Rd.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along S. PULASKI ROAD:
One (1) at eight (8) feet in length, eight (8) feet in height and eleven (11) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1110739 herein granted the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

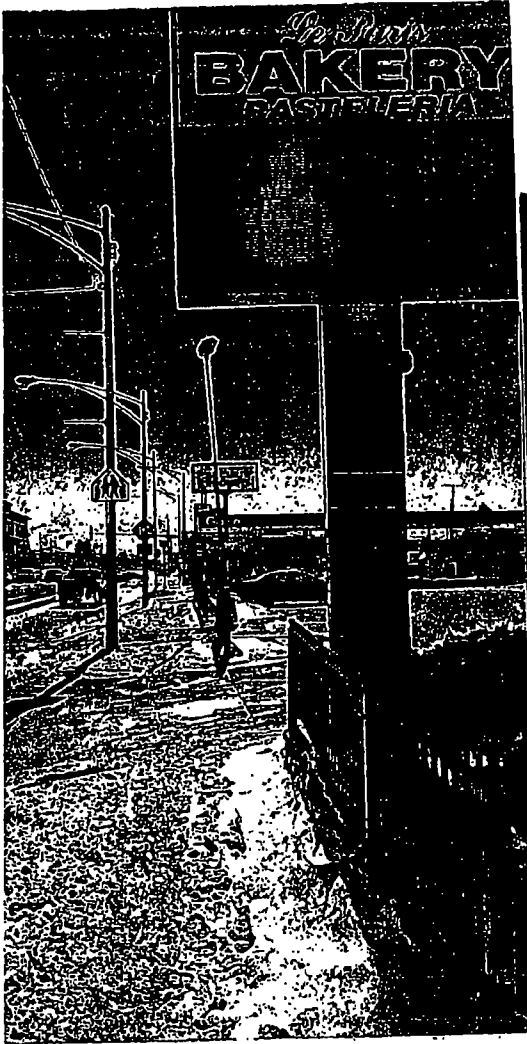



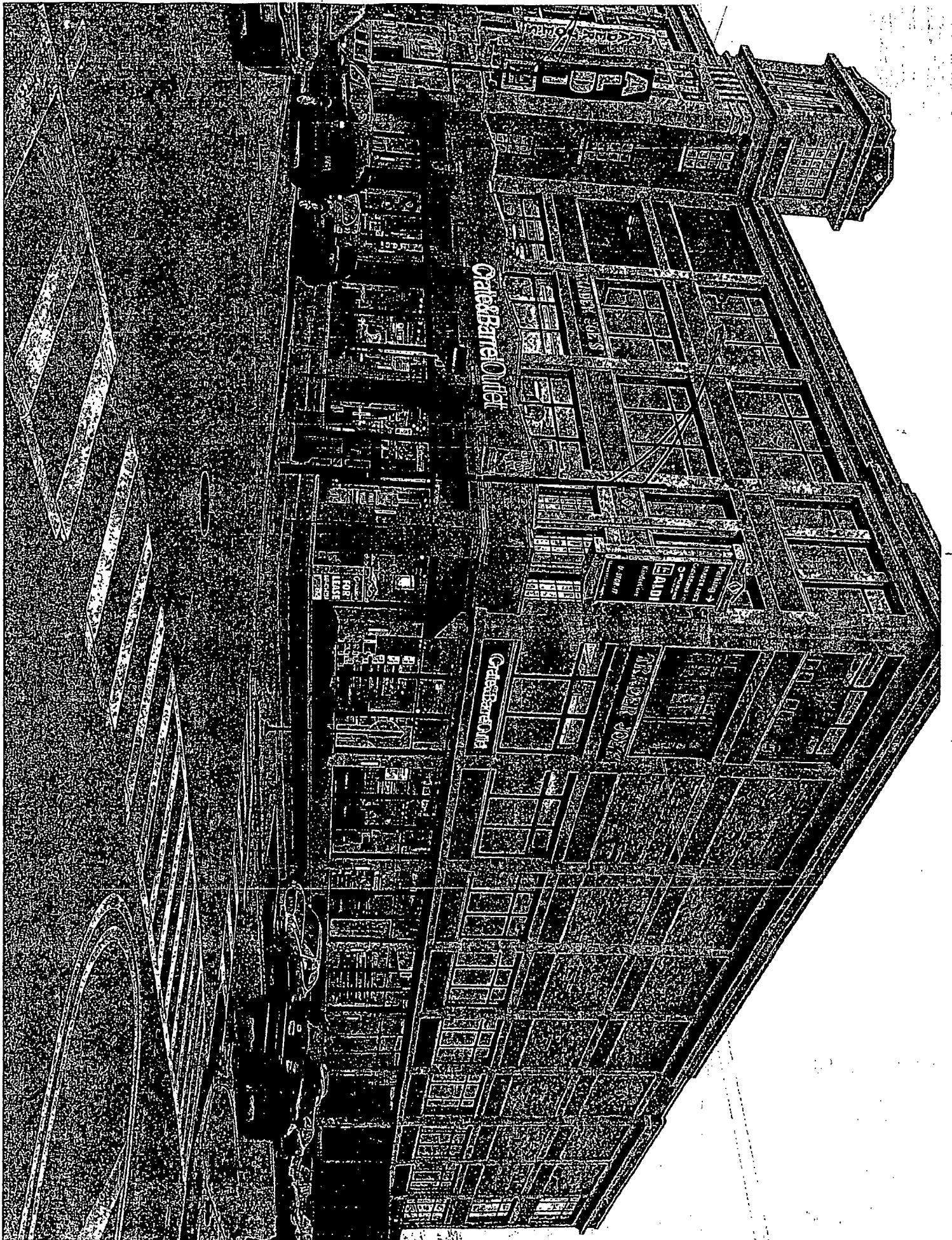

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LOU MITCHELL'S upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 565 W. Jackson Blvd.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be forty (40) feet in length and seven point six seven (7.67) feet in width for a total of three hundred six point eight (306.8) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along W.
