ORDINANCE ROSEBUD-RUSH Acct. No. 85994 - 2 Permit No. 1131241

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ROSEBUD-RUSH upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 55 E. Superior St.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be twenty-five point four two (25.42) feet in length and eleven (11) feet in width, area #2 shall be fifty (50) feet in length and seven (7) feet in width, area #3 shall be twenty-five point eight three (25.83) feet in length and ten (10) feet in width for a total of eight hundred eighty-seven point nine two (887.92) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. Rush Street, W Superior St. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday through Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Compensation: \$2,042.22 SEATING CAPACITY: 100

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1131241 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 1, 2018 through and including December 1, 2018.
