**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2-160 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding a new Section 2-160-075, underscored as follows:

**2-160-075 Priority parking signs.**

(a) Definitions. As used in this section:


"Garage," "operator," and "parking lot" have the same meanings as ascribed to those terms in Section 4-236-010.


"Military status" and "parental status" have the same meanings as ascribed to those terms in this Chapter.

"Pregnancy" has the same meaning as ascribed to that term in 775 ILCS 5/1-103.

(b) It shall not be a violation of this chapter, and shall not constitute a discriminatory activity, for an owner or operator of a parking lot or garage to create, place, and maintain signage indicating priority parking for individuals based upon military status, parental status, or pregnancy.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
