SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

12	South Rockwell Avenue and West Cullerton Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [O2018-4188]
12	South Campbell Avenue and West 39th Place; Stop Sign, Stopping South Campbell Avenue for West 39th Place [O2017-6768]
34	South Throop Street and West 114th Place; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (18-03172349) [Or2018-581]
34	South Sangamon Street and West 104th Street; All-Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches -- (18-03172370) [Or2018-582]
