## ORDINANCE

### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language, as follows:


**4-60-023      Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

- (19.34)      On Kedzie Avenue, from 103rd Street to 105th Street
- (19.35)      On Kedzie Avenue, from 105th Street to 107th Street
- (19.36)      On Kedzie Avenue, from 107th Street to 109th Street
- (19.37)      On Kedzie Avenue, from 109th Street to 111th Street
- (19.38)      On Kedzie Avenue, from 111th Street to 115th Street
- (19.39)      On the south side of 103rd Street, from Kedzie Avenue to Pulaski Road
- (19.40)      On the east side of Pulaski Road, from 103rd Street to 107th Street

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
