ORDINANCE


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (25.74), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of April 6, 2005 at pages 45951 through 45952, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (25.74) On Cermak Road, from Damen Avenue to Leavitt Street.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
