Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ORIOLE PARK SCHOOL, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, five (5) wrought iron Fence(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5424 N. Oketo Ave..

Said Fence(s) at W. Balmoral Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred twenty-eight (228) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of fifty-seven (57) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

One (1) at one hundred seventy-eight (178) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of forty-four point five (44.5) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

Said Fence(s) at N. Oketo Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred eighty-one (181) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of forty-five point two five (45.25) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

One (1) at seventy (70) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of seventeen point five (17.5) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

One (1) at twenty-five (25) feet in length, and point two five (.25) feet in width for a total of six point two five (6.25) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1119706 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.


A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
