ORDINANCE NORTHWESTERN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL Acct. No. 85392 - 6 Permit No. 1119521

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to NORTHWESTERN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, eight (8) Drain Tile(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 221 E. Huron St..

Said Drain Tile(s) at E. Huron Street measure(s):

One (1) at three hundred ninety-six (396) feet in length, and point three three (.33) feet in width for a total of one hundred thirty point six eight (130.68) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at N. Fairbank Street measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred sixty-six (166) feet in length, and point three three (.33) feet in width for a total of fifty-four point seven eight (54.78) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at E. Erie Street measure(s):

One (1) at three hundred thirty-two (332) feet in length, and point three three (.33) feet in width for a total of one hundred nine point five six (109.56) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at N. St Clair Street measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred thirty-four (134) feet in length, and point three three (.33) feet in width for a total of forty-four point two two (44.22) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at E. Huron Street measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-six (36) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of eighteen (18) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at N. Fairbank Street measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-four (24) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of twelve (12) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at E. Erie Street measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-six (36) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of eighteen (18) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

Said Drain Tile(s) at N. St Clair Street measure(s):

Öne (1) at twenty-four (24) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of twelve (12) square feet. Existing drain tile is approximately three (3) feet six (6) inches below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required Page 1

provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1119521 herein granted the sum of one thousand forty-eight (\$1,048.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 07/13/2015.
