Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 1028 N RUSH ST CORP, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, apportion of the sidewalk are on the south side of East Bellevue Place, between the east side of North State Street and the west side of North Rush Street adjacent to its premises known as 1028 North Rush Street. Existing area is approximately ten (10) feet in width extending in a north and south direction from the property line and a length extending east and west approximately sixty-six (66) feet for a total use of six hundred sixty (660) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1099082 herein granted the sum of twenty thousand four hundred twenty (\$20,420.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 12/19/2011.
