RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of ninety-three; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of her passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone was the devoted wife of the late Edgar Corry and William Boone; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone was the much-adored mother of Larry and David Corry, Sheila Carlstedt, the stepmother of William and Andrew Boone, Carol Strohbehn, Stewart Gilgis and Ann McFarland, the grandmother of three and the great-grandmother of seven; and

WHEREAS, A longtime resident of Glencoe, the Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone served for thirteen years as chairwoman of Pace, the Chicago area's suburban transit agency; and

WHEREAS, During the 1970s, the Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone served as President of the New Trier Board of Education, and was subsequently elected President of the Village of Glencoe; and


WHEREAS, The Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone was appointed by Governor James Thompson to the Regional Transportation Authority Board and assumed chairmanship of Pace upon its creation in the mid 1980s; and

WHEREAS, A lifelong musician, the Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone was supportive of, and actively involved with, both the Lyric Opera and the Music Institute of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, the Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this sixth day of June, 2012, do hereby commemorate the Honorable Florence Hagenah Boone for her grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to her family; and
