BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the RS3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 20-I in the area bound by

West 79th Street; a line 83.66 feet west of and parallel to South Mozart Street; the alley next south of and parallel to West 79th Street; and a line 108.66 feet west of and parallel to South Mozart Street

to those of a B1-1 Neighborhood Shopping District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.


