WHEREAS, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews has announced his retirement from the United States Air Force after thirty years of dedicated service; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of this event by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, A native of Chicago, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews began his career with the Air Force upon graduation in 1982 from Downers Grove North High School; and

WHEREAS, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews served with the United States Air Force as a weather observer and forecaster, Station Chief, and Squadron Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews earned an Associate of Applied Science degree from the Community College of the Air Force, and a Bachelor of Science degree from Southern Illinois University; and

WHEREAS, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews' most recent role with the Air Force was as Superintendent of the 1st Weather Squadron at the Offutt Air Force Base in Nebraska, where he advised the Commander on the morale, welfare and readiness of more than four-hundred enlisted personnel; and

WHEREAS, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews is the recipient of numerous honors for his military service, including the Meritorious Service Medal, the Air Force Commendation Medal, and the Air Force Achievement Medal, all with two oak leaf clusters; and *WHEREAS,* Through his diligence, patriotism, and devotion to country, Chief Master Sergeant John L. Andrews has exemplified the highest standards of an American soldier; now, therefore
