**ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Chicago is a home rule unit government as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, As a home rule unit of government, the City of Chicago may exercise any power and perform any function relating to its government and affairs including protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Chicago invites, encourages, and supports small businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, The food truck industry has shown the ability to create new employment opportunities for culinary entrepreneurs in Chicago; and

**WHEREAS**, Increasing the length of time that trucks can stay in one location will encourage growth of the food truck community; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 7-38-115 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored, and by deleting the language struck through, as follows:


**7-38-115 Operational requirements.**

(b) Mobile food vehicle stops shall be made only to service customers and shall not exceed ~~(i) a total of two six hours a day or (ii) the maximum permitted period for parking, whichever is lesser,~~ in any one block.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
