***WHEREAS***, Michael Olivieri was a generous and energetic leader who put the needs of others ahead of his own; and

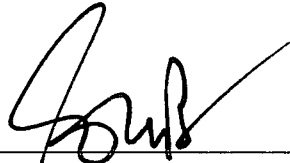
