BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-152-120 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language stricken through and by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

2-152-120 Badges for employees.


(a) The head of every department or other agency of the city government shall furnish, at the expense of the city, a badge of authority to each employee in his department or agency whose duties bring ~~him~~ such employee in contact with the public at places other than the City Hall or other municipal buildings. ~~a Such badge of authority, showing shall indicate the nature of the employment of such person such person's employment by the department or agency, which badge and shall be worn by the employee~~ at all times when the employee is on duty.

The badges issued in each department or agency shall be numbered in consecutive order, and the name of the employee to whom each number is issued shall be kept in a register maintained by the head of the department or agency. ~~In case any such employee~~ If a person to whom a badge is issued under this section ceases to be in the employ of employed by the city; or shall be is transferred to some other a position where such badge is not required, he such person shall immediately surrender such badge to the head of the department or agency identified on the badge.

(b) If It shall be unlawful for any person who is not an employee of the city or who is not otherwise lawfully in possession of any badge issued under subsection (a) of this section to shall wear, display or use any such badge; or to cause such badge to be worn, displayed or used. he Any person who violates this subsection (b) shall be fined not less than \$10.00 \$500.00 nor more than \$100.00 \$1,000.00 for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person, with the intent to defraud or deceive any other person, to impersonate an officer or employee of the city or to otherwise falsely represent himself or herself to be an officer or employee of the city. Any person who violates this subsection (c) shall be fined not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
