WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of this significant occasion by The Honorable Margaret Laurino, Alderman of the 39th Ward; and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments, managed by Elderly Housing Development and Operations Corporation (EHDOC), is a 240-unit, low-income, senior housing facility, located on the northwest side of Chicago in an area called North Park Village; and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments is the result of the combined efforts of the Chicago Metropolitan Area Senior Citizens (CMASCS), under the tireless direction of Mr. Jerry Prete, the National Council of Senior Citizens (NCSC) and the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments has professional, specially trained on-site management that is committed to ensuring that apartments, common areas, and grounds are well-maintained; and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments encourages residents to "age in place", living independently, with dignity and self-determination in a community with their peers; and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments has outstanding service coordinators that identify and partner with resources in the surrounding community to provide needed services; and

WHEREAS, Senate Apartments is considered to be one of the nicest senior citizen apartment buildings in the nation; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved, That we, the Mayor and members of the City Council of the City of Chicago, gathered here this fifth day of October, 2011, do hereby extend our heartiest congratulations to Senate Apartments on their thirtieth anniversary and wish Senate Apartments every success in all of their future endeavors; and
