## **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, On July 1, 2013, Croatia will officially join the European Union; and

*WHEREAS,* The Chicago City Council has been informed of this landmark event by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

*WHEREAS,* In 2003, Croatia officially applied for membership in the European Union; and

WHEREAS, The European Union admits new member states that meet certain stringent criteria; and

WHEREAS, The first criterion is "stability of institutions guaranteeing democracy, the rule of law, human rights and respect for and protection of minorities;" and

**WHEREAS**, The second set of criteria includes "a functioning market economy and the capacity to cope with competition and market forces within the Union;" and

**WHEREAS**, The third set mandates "the candidate's ability to take on the obligations of membership including adherence to the aims of political, economic and monetary union;" and

*WHEREAS*, In the past ten years, Croatia has worked hard to meet these criteria, and its entry to the European Union will be finalized on July 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, On July 1, 2013, Chicago's Croatian Consul General, Dr. Jelena Grčić Polić, will host an event celebrating the admission of Croatia as the twentyeighth member of the European Union; and

**WHEREAS**, Chicago is the proud home to a vibrant Croatian community that has made significant contributions to the growth and success of our city over the years; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this twenty-sixth day of June, 2013, do hereby congratulate Croatia on its formal accession to the European Union; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Consul General of Croatia in Chicago in recognition of this historic event.
