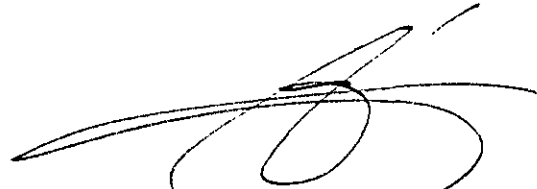

Dear Alderman Colón:

The Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) has received a request through the 311 system to convert the intersection of Shakespeare Avenue and Richmond Street to an all-way stop. The intersection is currently a two-way stop-controlled intersection with traffic on Richmond Street given the right-of-way. The caller requested stop signs on Richmond Street due to overall safety concerns. Since both streets are residential streets, CDOT would not be opposed to an all-way stop at this intersection. If this is something you would like to pursue, please introduce the following ordinance language to City Council:

All-Way Stop signs – N. Richmond St. and W. Shakespeare Ave.

CDOT will implement the appropriate sign and pavement marking modifications once this ordinance language passes. Please contact this office at 312-744-1987 if you have any questions.
