Grant(s) of privilege in public way for Wyndham Grand Chicago Riverfront Committee on Transportation and Public Way

ORDINANCE WYNDHAM GRAND CHICAGO RIVERFRONT Acct. No. 375959 - 1 Permit No. 1137768

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to WYNDHAM GRAND CHICAGO RIVERFRONT, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Handicap Ramp(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 71 E. Wacker Dr..

Said Handicap Ramp(s) at E. Wacker Dr. measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-one point five (31.5) feet in length, and fourteen point two five (14.25) feet in width for a total of four hundred forty-eight point eight (448.88) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1137768 herein granted the sum of twenty-seven thousand four hundred seventy-one (\$27,471.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 01/13/2019.
