## ORDINANCE

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as *new* subsections 4-60-022(2.173 through 2.175), as follows:

**4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

(2.173) Commencing at the intersection of Sacramento Boulevard and Wilcox Street and proceeding north on the east side only of Sacramento Boulevard to Madison Street thence proceeding east on both sides of Madison Street to the intersection of Madison Street and Francisco Avenue thence proceeding south on both sides of Francisco Avenue to Wilcox Street.

(2.174) On 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, from Sacramento Boulevard to Francisco Avenue.

(2.175) On Monroe Street, from Sacramento Boulevard to Francisco Avenue.

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

**SECTION 3.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as new subsections 4-60-023(2.177 through 2.179), as follows:

**4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:


(2.177) Commencing at the intersection of Sacramento Boulevard and Wilcox Street and proceeding north on the east side only of Sacramento Boulevard to Madison Street thence proceeding east on both sides of Madison Street to the intersection of Madison Street and Francisco Avenue thence proceeding south on both sides of Francisco Avenue to Wilcox Street.

(2.178)      On 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, from Sacramento Boulevard to Francisco Avenue.

(2.179)      On Monroe Street, from Sacramento Boulevard to Francisco Avenue.

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
