WHEREAS, It is with great sadness that members of this Chamber learned of the death of Louis E. Grassi, on July 15, 2015, at the age of eighty-seven; and


WHEREAS, The City Council has been informed of his passing by The Honorable Margaret Laurino, Alderman of the 39th Ward; and
